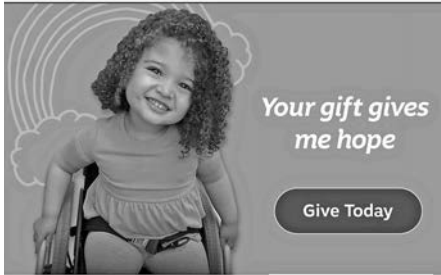

## Introducing CryoSPHERE: Pain Control Procedure

In February, pediatric general surgeon, Michael V. Tirabassi, M.D., one of our consulting physicians from Baystate Medical Center, performed the first case using the CryoSPHERE pain control procedure following Nuss bar surgery for pectus excavatum.



Roughly 1 in 400 children are born with pectus excavatum, in which the breastbone (sternum) is indented or sunken. This condition can lead to compression and displacement of the heart and lungs, which can lead to further complications if not treated. The Nuss bar procedure is a minimally invasive surgery where a steel bar is implanted across the patient's chest behind the breastbone. The bar pushes the sunken part of the chest out, correcting the pectus excavatum. This procedure has helped hundreds of children since 1998, when the chest wall deformity clinic first began here in Springfield.

Recovery from the Nuss bar surgery is lengthy and often times very painful for patients due to the sudden, dramatic change in their chest. With the CryoSPHERE pain control procedure, the nerves in the surgical area are temporarily frozen during surgery, minimizing the use of pain relieving narcotics and overall length of stay in the hospital.

Patients who undergo Nuss bar surgery typically require a 4-5 night post-operative stay in the hospital. An epidural catheter is used to control the patient's pain post-surgery, before transitioning to high doses of oral oxycodone. With CryoSPHERE, the patient's epidural catheter can be turned off less than 24 hours after surgery and the patient will likely not need any doses of oxycodone and can be discharged after just two nights.

High doses of narcotics have many consequences for patients. Constipation can be a major issue, causing patients to lose their appetite, feel nauseous and have abdominal pain after their procedure. In addition, the use of narcotics for pain lasts a couple of weeks postoperatively, so there is a concern for becoming addicted to opioids while trying to control pain. This can be life altering.

"The CryoSPHERE is a real game changer for this surgery," said Dr. Tirabassi with pride. "It cuts the post-operative hospital stay in half and many patients will not require any narcotic pain medications." This is an important selling point for families when discussing this surgery for their child. The goal with implementing CryoSPHERE is to help even more children get correction of their chest deformities as safely and painlessly as possible.

## Telethon 2021 a Success!

### Safety at the George R. Brown Convention Center



The George R. Brown Convention Center (GRB) has earned accreditation from the Global Biorisk Advisory Council (GBAC) STAR™ Facility Accreditation Program – the industry gold standard of safe facilities.

In early September 2020, the GRB became the first convention center in the nation to implement Medistar Corp's new biodefense air filtration system proven to eliminate a number of airborne contaminants, including COVID-19.

Since January 6 of this year, the GRB has successfully welcomed nearly 300,000 attendees at several large events including the Mizuno Cross Court Volleyball Tournament in March. The facility remains active daily, and has hosted up to 21,000 guests in a single day, all while maintaining the highest standards of public safety.

#### Additional Safety Measures

- The GRB now has 20 EMist 360 electrostatic disinfectant sprayers, which are used at the end of each day to sanitize all common areas throughout the GRB as well as meeting rooms being used during events.
- The NUCTECH infrared face temperature screening system FeverBlock provides a non-contact solution for large scene temperature measurement and screening.
- 65 permanent hand sanitizing locations throughout the facility
- New sliding doors for touchless entry
- Touchless water fountains
- Touchless payment options at food vendors
- UV Sanitizer on escalator handrails
- The GRB is part of the Houston Clean initiative, a citywide task force committed to enhanced health precautions designed to mitigate virus spread.
