Welcome Spring! After a cold and long winter, we can ditch the overcoats and welcome the beautiful flowers AND see many friends again who have been hibernating.







# SHRINERS COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERING GUIDELINES SHRINERS INTERNATIONAL: OFFICE OF MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

To outline the scope and process for Temples, Clubs, Units, Nobles and their families to increase their visibility and contributions within their community through volunteering

### **COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS:**

There are two primary methods by which a temple, club, unit, nobles and their families can support local charities and/or community-based organizations other than Shriners Hospitals for Children or Shriners International Education Foundation. The activity must qualify under a De Minimis Safe Harbor (something of little actual cost) or the Temple must seek written approval for a joint charitable fundraising activity as spelled out in General Order No. 1., Fundraising Activities.

### De Minimis Safe Harbor

There is an understood and practiced exception for temples, clubs, or units to participate in community-based activities and events not related to approved Shriner International charities through the concept of a de minimis safe harbor.

The de minimis safe harbor permits the temple, club, or unit to pursue support of or participation in a community-based activities qualified as too small to be meaningful or taken into consideration; immaterial, as compared to ongoing efforts in support of

De minimis contributions of fraternal funds should be considered and included when a temple prepares its annual operating budget.

Examples of qualified de minimis contributions include:

- Temple sponsoring a child's sports team (e.g. little league) for \$500.00
- Nobles volunteering to serve in a homeless soup kitchen
- A club or unit collecting items for donation to an animal shelter
- Temples hosting a blood donor drive on their property
- Nobles and their families volunteering time to repair a community center
- Temple making a \$500.00 donation to enhance a local playground
- Temple providing limited promotions about the activity or cause in a Shrine newsletter
- A club or unit making a donation to a Masonic foundation for \$200.00
- · Nobles and their families volunteering to pick up on local roads, parks, and/or beaches
- A club or unit buying \$300.00 in flowers and planting them in a community park
- Temple installing and fixing community signs
- Nobles and their families volunteering to clean up an overgrown cemetery

Key attributes in defining if an activity would qualify under de minimis safe harbor include:

- Activity is time bound, e.g. once a year and not as an ongoing operation of the temple • Activity has limited human capital requirements, e.g. volunteering to support the activity should not adversely affect the ability for the temple to support ongoing volunteer requirements to support approved charities
- Cumulative Temple (including its Units) or Shrine Club monetary donations do not exceed \$1,000.00 annually.

If defining an activity under de minimis safe harbor is in doubt, please contact Temple Accounting at templeaccounting@shrinenet.org for guidance.

De minimis donations of temple fraternal funds should not be confused with fraternal fundraising or charitable fundraising.

### **FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES**

Nobles can fundraise fraternally to benefit their temple, clubs and units with the written permission of the temple potentate.

Nobles can fundraise charitably to the public benefiting SHC only, with the exceptions being an approved event with another 501(c)(3) where a minimum of 50% of the proceeds benefit SHC, and a charitable fundraising activity conducted by a temple outside of the U.S.A., being authorized for other charities.

Permission to conduct charitable fundraising must be first obtained in writing from the temple Potentate. The temple Potentate must then obtain written permission from the chairmen of the boards of directors and trustees.

You are encouraged to read the fundraising materials in General Order No. 1, Series of 2022-2023, pages 37-42 to further your knowledge of Shrine fundraising rules.

### **APPROVED CHARITIES:**

Shriners Children's (Shriners Hospitals for Children) is the exclusive - Shrine charity with the limited exception of de minimis contribution to local charities and community groups. Nobles may also contribute, and encourage other Nobles to contribute and engage in charitable fundraising activities directly to Nobles and their families for the benefit of the Shriners International Education Foundation (SIEF).

### **MEDIA & PR:**

Engaging the local media when helping your community to thrive may serve as a great opportunity to raise awareness of the Shrine..
