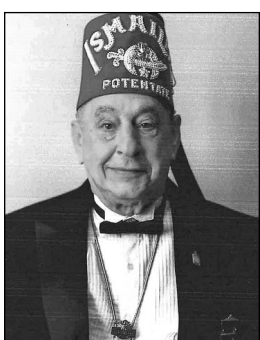

These *Smile* articles are usually turned in by the 20th of each month for the following month publication, so because of that, there were a couple of events that I wanted to let you know about in June. On June 23, the Divan traveled to the Allegany Shrine Club to install four new members. The club also made a very generous donation to the Shrine. That gives us 9 new members for May and June. On June 25, we had the West Seneca Community Days parade. The Legion of Honor was there to present the colors, the Directors brought their fire engine, and Mark Akerman, also known as "Mr. Fez Head", walked the entire length of the parade with our Asst. Rabban, Mike Ferraro, assisting in about 90 degree temperature. Thank you to all that came out. The number one question asked during the parade is: "Where are those little cars". The Mini Kars was always a high profile unit at the parade, but we are having a difficult time getting new members to join the Mini Kars. If you are interested, we have cars available.

The Imperial Convention of Shriner's International was held in Minneapolis from July 2 - 7, and Kenny Craven was elected as our new Imperial Potentate. This is the first time the Shriner's had a positive growth in membership in about 30 years, up about 3%. Our hospitals treated 420 thousand kids in 2021. This is a 26% increase. They cut the hospital budget by 200 million dollars by restructuring and down-sizing some of the hospitals. A vote was brought up to

increase the per-capita by \$20.00 a year, the members voted it down, wanting more cuts. A vote was also brought up to stop the \$20.00 a day meal allowance for Shriners' wives, in order to save a little more money. They pointed out that most companies don't pay for your wife's meals when you have to go out of town for business. That was also voted down. I'm not sure what kind of "cuts" the members are looking for. The parade in Minneapolis was smaller than usual, less than 2 hours. Past Potentate, Doug Foss did walk the parade as a clown with the Canadian Maid of the Mist boat. If you have never attended one of the Imperial sessions, you should consider checking it out. It is open to all Shriners. Next year's convention will be held in Charlotte SC. And Mike Ferraro's year (2024) will be in Reno, NV, so mark your calendar to see what one of these conventions are all about. As long as you aren't a voting member, you can participate as much or as little as you want.

The Ladies of the Nile gave one of the largest donations to Shriner's Hospitals of over 2 million dollars. It always amazes me what the ladies are able to donate; great job!

Check your *Smile* calendar for the dates of a couple activities going on in August. And last, either call the office or let the Asst. Rabban Mike Ferraro know if you are coming to the Family Picnic, August 27th. @ 12:00 pm. Bring the kids and grand kids out for a hot dog or hamburger.

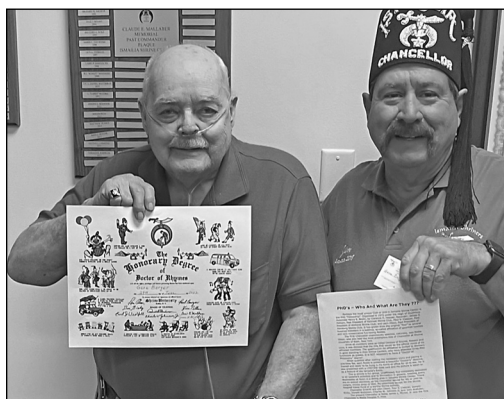

Most Worshipful Kessler proudly wore his Grand Master's Fez while he attended the Imperial Session in Minneapolis.

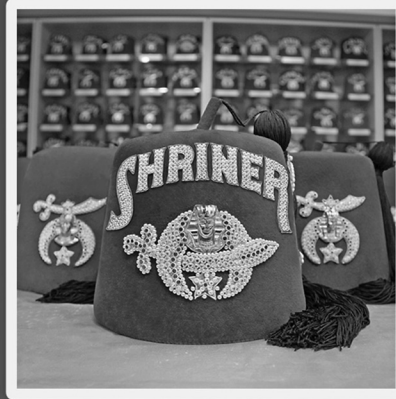
