
The Imperial Convention of Shriner's International was held in Minneapolis from July 2 - 7, and Kenny Craven was elected as our new Imperial Potentate. This is the first time the Shriner's had a positive growth in membership in about 30 years, up about 3%. Our hospitals treated 420 thousand kids in 2021. This is a 26% increase. They cut the hospital budget by 200 million dollars by restructuring and down-sizing some of the hospitals. A vote was brought up to attended one of the Imperial sessions, you should consider checking it out. It is open to all Shriners. Next year's convention will be held in Charlotte SC. And Mike Ferraro's year (2024) will be in Reno, NV, so mark your calendar to see what one of these conventions are all about. As long as you aren't a voting member, you can participate as much or as little as you want.

The Ladies of the Nile gave one of the largest donations to Shriner's Hospitals of over 2 million dollars. It always amazes me what the ladies are able to donate; great job!






