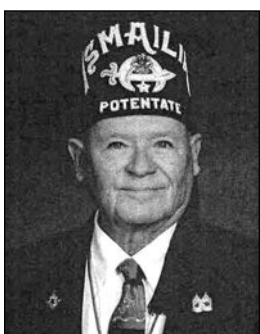

Welcome Summer! The members of Ailiamsi Court no. 12 have many fun activities and service projects to fill our warm, summer days.

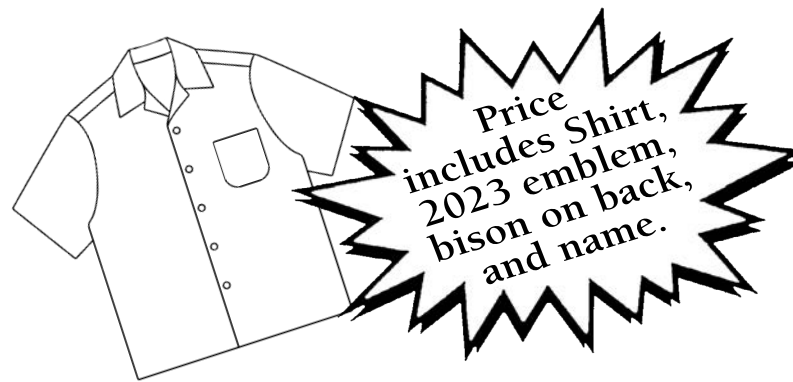
