### WHAT IS AN AED

Sudden cardiac arrest is among the leading causes of death in the United States. In fact, more than 350,000 people will suffer a cardiac arrest this year. Currently, the only way to restore a regular heart rhythm during cardiac arrest is to use an AED.



If you're wondering what an AED is and why they seem to be located in most offices and public buildings, you're not alone. In fact, because these devices are now commonly available, more people than ever before are curious about them. So, just what is an AED?

An AED is a portable device that is used to diagnose and treat those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest and/or ventricular fibrillation (VF) and pulseless ventricular tachycardia (VT). Although it's a sophisticated medical device, they are easy to use and intended to be used by laypeople who have received minimal training.

An AED works by sending a shock through the victim's chest to stop these life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias. This allows the heart to re-establish a sustainable pulse.

Immediate CPR and defibrillation within 3-5 minutes give the victim the best chance of survival. The chances of survival decrease by nearly 50% if a victim in cardiac arrest is not defibrillated within 5 minutes. The chances of survival decrease another 7% each additional minute without defibrillation. So when seconds matter, having an AED readily available is the fastest way to provide life-saving treatment.

However, because the average response time for first responders once 911 is called is 8-12 minutes, and for each minute defibrillation is delayed, the odds of survival are reduced by approximately 10%, having access to an AED and knowing how to use one, is critical.

One comprehensive review of AED cost-effectiveness found that the true cost of owning a defibrillator is about \$200 per year. The researchers estimated this number based on the average cost of a new AED (\$2,000) divided by the average expected lifespan of the device (10 years).

Considering that a standard Netflix account costs \$156 per year, it's a small price to pay for such an invaluable piece of equipment-especially if you operate an organization where emergencies might occur.

The Ismailia Shriners have a number of older members who are more likely to sustain a cardiac event. But as we saw recently with Damar Hamlin of the buffalo Bills, younger people can still experience a cardiac event! At this time our Shrine Center does not have an AED in the building. For everyone's safety we need one!

The PhD Lunch club has looked into purchasing one for our Shrine Center. Unfortunately the cost is prohibitive for most clubs or units to purchase on their own.

We are looking for two or three other clubs/units to join us in making this important purchase for our building.

### **CPR / AED class**

Looking for anyone that may be interested in taking a CPR/AED course. Due to popular demand, some of the pricing has increased for these courses. Below is a quick detail that I received from Buffalo CPR on the above course that is available:

The type of CPR class your group would receive is called Heartsaver CPR with AED training (it's CPR training for the Non Medical professional). The course is 3 hours in length. The cost is \$55.00 per person and the fee includes a CPR manual for each participant. We do require a minimum enrollment or billing of 8 to train on-site. At the completion of the class each person will receive an official American Heart Association 2 year CPR certification card.

Please let me know if you have any questions or would like to look at availability. I need to have at least 8 members for this course to schedule.







### Famous Masons: Douglas MacArthur

Born January 26, 1880 Initiated January 17, 1936 (On Sight) Raised Died April 5, 1964
Douglas MacArthur was born on January 26, 1880 in Little Rock, Arkansas. Raised in a military
family, MacArthur graduated valedictorian, at the West Texas Military Academy. He later graduated
from West Point's United States Military Academy in 1903 at the top of his class as First Captain.
During WWI, MacArthur was raised to the rank of brigadier general, and by 1944, became "5 star"
General of the Army. Among his awards and decorations (many of which were awarded multiple times)
are the Medal of Honor, Distinguished Service Cross, the Army and Navy's Distinguished Service Medal,
the Distinguished Flying Cross, and the Silver Star. General MacArthur was made a Mason on January
17th, 1936 under the auspices of the Grand Lodge of the Philippines, and performed by Past Grand
Masters Frederick Stevens, Francisco Delgado, Most Worshipful Samuel Hawthorne, and witnessed by
over 600 Master Masons. He later affiliated with Manila Lodge No. 1, and joined the Scottish Rite of
Freemasonry in 1937 where he was later coroneted Inspector General 33rd Degree, and was also a life
member of Nile Shrine Temple in Seattle, Washington. Brother MacArthur was called from labor on
April 5, 1964 and is laid to rest at the Douglas MacArthur Memorial in Norfolk, Virginia.
