



In this setting, pediatric orthopedic clinicians will be working alongside other UHealth Jackson Children's Care signature pediatric services, which include organ transplant, cardiac care, neonatology, cancer treatment, neurosurgery, and more.

The commitment includes a new, state-of-the-art facility. Scheduled to open in 2025, the new building will be located steps from Holtz Children's Hospital.







Later he returned to Texas to conduct his 32 degree work where he joined the Shriners. Audie remained active in various masonic events and was a member of good standing at the time of his death.






