Dear Fellow Nobles,

Last week, thousands of people experienced horrors like never before as catastrophic wildfires scorched the Hawaiian island of Maui, killing more than 90 people and destroying most of the historic town of Lahaina. With search-and-recovery efforts ongoing, the death toll is still expected to rise from what are already considered the deadliest U.S. wildfires in more than 100 years.

I have personally been in contact with Masonic leaders from the impacted communities, including the Grand Master of Hawaii, Dustin Verity, to assess the damage and pledge the support of Shriners International during this time. Most Worshipful Verity and I discussed the Shriners and our Masonic Brothers on Maui, and the destruction involved. He visited the Maui Lodge on Wednesday evening, and said:

"When I visited the Brothers at the Lodge on Wednesday, everyone was in good spirits even though some had just lost all their material possessions, their homes, their jobs, and their farms. They were there not to ask for support, but to enjoy the fellowship. They knew that they would be taken care of because we all embrace the basic tenants of Freemasonry - Brotherly love, relief, and truth."

During times like these, outreach from around the world from our Brothers shows us what we are truly made of. Please hold our Brothers, and every person in Maui, in your hearts as they attempt to recover from this unfathomable devastation. Perhaps we need a real review of anything else that costs money or is supposed to make money – including Clubs. B. While it may be a little more difficult to execute, we need to turn all of our activities and our physical space into a profit center wherever possible.

What do I mean? . Increase the usage of our great facilities for weddings, corn hole tournaments, meetings, etc etc so we can build our rental income. • Let's take a look at our arrangement with the YMCA. The arrangement is that they park for free in exchange for cutting the grass and shoveling the snow. Nobles get to use the Y for free and the family gets a break as well. Every day we have hundreds of cars parking in our lot. When the deal was designed, the world was a whole lot different than today. One of only a bunch of ideas is that the Y could charge their members \$25 a month for parking. They get 10 and we get 15. Just an idea...this would be an amazing steady income stream for the Shrine.

These are just a few examples – there are lots more all of you have been thinking about also...The way to fix these issues is through discussion and action. We NEED TO GET TOGETHER AS AN ENTITY. WE NEED TO START USING BRAIN POWER THAT IS WASTED JUST WATCHING TV. My proposal is simple. Those of us who would like to turn the Shrine around and can help out should call Joe Hoerner at the Shrine 716-674-8666.
