

They are the ones that often set-up tables for various functions, repair everything that breaks, from refrigerators that don't cool, doors that don't close; and they do a lot of clean-up after some of the various functions.

I attended the installation of officers for the Nile and also for Ailiamsi. It was a very nice event and some great food served. If you never attended one of these installations, come out and support our lady organizations; they do an awful lot for the Shrine and our hospitals.





We launched a new program across Shriners International, which will benefit your temple and its membership engagement!

The "Fun & Fellowship Connect" is a membership initiative designed to gather demographic information from current and prospective Nobles, and prompt your temple's Clubs and Units to identify their primary purpose - from a predetermined set of interest areas: Sports & Adventure; Musical, Performing & Parading; Leisure Activities & Recreation; Volunteer Service; Professional Development; Social Gatherings.
